

International journals

The university libraries offer not only literature of all kinds but also a few selected international newspapers and magazines.

At the Adolf-Reichwein-Campus library, issues of the current month's journals can always be found on level 0 in the newspaper display. Issues from the previous five months can be borrowed on level (-1). The international newspapers and magazines available are the following:

Guardian weekly	The Guardian weekly is an international English-language news magazine based in London. It is one of the oldest international news publications in the world and its content is based on its sister publications The Guardian and the Sunday newspaper The Observer, all of which are published by the Guardian Media Group. Le monde	Le Monde is a French national newspaper and one of the most important opinion-forming newspapers in France. It is politically left-wing liberal and indirectly linked to the newspaper Le Monde diplomatique..	Call number: 00-01M3
Neue Zürcher Zeitung	The Neue Zürcher Zeitung - called "Zürizytig" in the Züricher dialect - is a German newspaper with a long tradition that is nationally well-known.	Call number: 00-01N3

The New York Times	The New York Times is an influential national US daily newspaper and the largest newspaper publication in the USA, publishing over 30 print journals in total.	Call number: 00-01I9
