

Application for partial scholarships for incoming exchange students at the Faculty of Arts and Humanities

The Faculty of Arts and Humanities awards a total of four partial scholarships each year with the aim of strengthening and promoting the internationalization of the faculty and student exchange. The scholarship of a maximum of 2500 euros is open to students of all disciplines at the Faculty of Arts and Humanities. It is intended exclusively for students from non-European partner universities of the Faculty of Arts and Humanities and, in justified exceptional cases, for students from other, non-European universities that have not entered into a formal partnership yet. The scholarship enables students to study at the Faculty of Arts and Humanities for at least one semester.

Applications are to be sent to the Commission for International Affairs of the Faculty of Arts and Humanities. There are two application periods: 15th April to 01st May for the winter semester and 15th October to 1st November for the summer semester.
